This young lady was referred to the Neuro Ophthalmology clinic today on account of asymptomatic optic disc appearance by her optometrist.

DIAGNOSIS: No abnormality

Gaia is asymptomatic. She has low level myopia in the right eye and her past medical history includes eczema, asthma and hay fever. She does not take any regular medications, she does not have any significant family history and has no symptoms on functional inquiry to indicate any health problems and specifically nil to indicate raised intracranial pressure. She works in tech, does not smoke and drinks alcohol in moderation.

On examination her visual acuity was 6/5 with pin hole in both eyes with full colour vision, normal pupil reactive, no RAPD, full movement, no double vision, full fields to confrontation and a healthy appearance of the optic nerve, macula and retina. OCT imaging confirmed no oedema of the optic discs or signs of optic disc drusen. I have reassured her and discharged her from further neuro

ophthalmic follow up.
